

## **The Kiel University is implementing a waste prevention concept.**

In order to get climate-neutral before 2030 and to fulfil one of the defined goals of the in 2011/2012 introduced environmental management system according to EMAS, the Kiel University (CAU) to in cooperation with the student working group waste prevention and the company cyclos developed a waste prevention concept. The concept includes concrete measures based on the principle of provision and sustainability in order to ensure the best possible protection for people and environment. The project was funded by the National Climate Protection Initiative of the German Government. The composition of the waste of the CAU was analysed during two sorting campaigns. These values are used to identify and evaluate various proportions of the generated waste. With this basis, relevant waste prevention potentials and were derived and in further steps measures had been developed and implemented. These measures and methods concern sustainable procurement measures as well as a sensitized usage and user behaviour like waste preventing consumption.
